1 Down: This rating scale assesses executive functioning and self-regulation skills in children and teens.

2 Down: Statement from NASP: "Our logo mark, the Psi Tree, ____ just the combination of the symbol for psychology and the tree of learning, it also represents our commitment to continuous growth as an organization and a profession."

3 Down: Similar to student support teams (SST) and child study teams (CST), this acronym is used in many districts to refer to educators at the RTI/MTSS meetings.

4 Down: This acronym refers to law enforcement officers working in schools.

5 Down: NASP's annual summer training that teaches school psychologists how to advocate for the profession at the local, state, and national level.
